The following motion was presented and approved at the June 21, 2011 meeting of the Ada Music Boosters...

Policy on Student Fund-Raising Accounts

The motion was made by Jeff Oestreich...

A student account shall be created to manage the proceeds from fund-raising earnings. Once a student begins participating in fund-raising efforts for the Ada Music Boosters (usually in fifth or sixth grade), the amount credited to the student's account will carry forward from then until the time of graduation, or the student is no longer active in the music department of Ada Exempted Village Schools. Funds not used at the time of graduation or upon leaving the music department may be carried over to a sibling currently participating in the music department of Ada Schools. Should the student not use the funds in their accounts for a sponsored trip(s), the funds will be available to help offset fees incurred for Marching Band, Varsity Singers or any other additional costs required for the music department programs in which they participate, at the discretion of the parent or legal guardian. All requests must be presented to the Treasurer or Assistant Treasurer in writing; for the purposes of this policy, e-mail will be considered a request submitted in writing. Any funds not used or applied to a sibling account, as noted, above, will become part of the general treasury of the Ada Music Boosters at the time of graduation or upon leaving the music department. If a student returns to the music department after a time away, the account will begin from zero from that point forward.

After discussion, the motion was seconded by Dawn Waugh. The vote was in favor of the motion and it passed.
